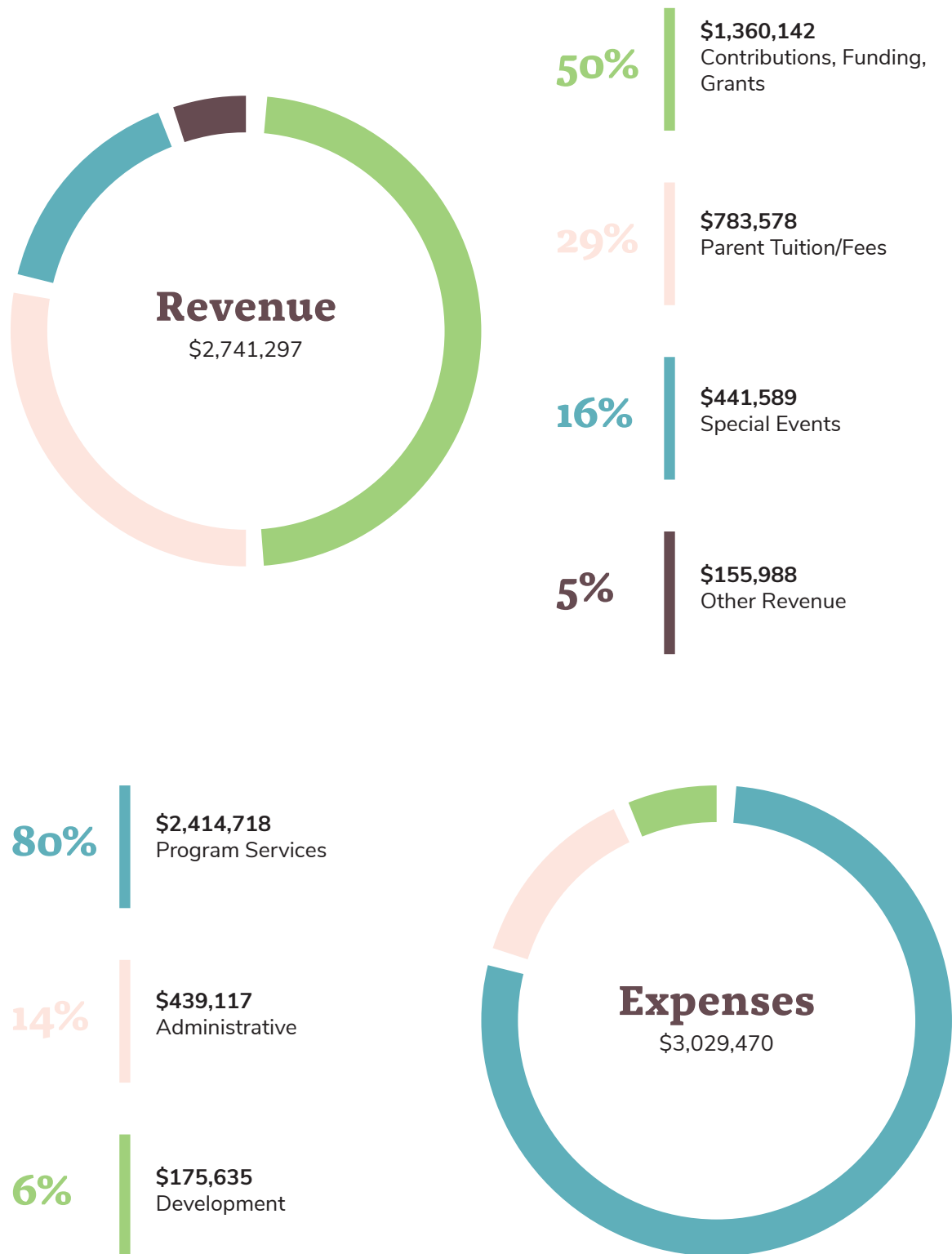

Their journey led to the founding of Magnolia Speech School for the Deaf in September 1956, with Mrs. Elizabeth S. Matthews as director. Over the years, the school evolved from a single class of seven students to a thriving institution, constantly outgrowing facilities as it expanded to meet the needs of more children.

Today, Magnolia Speech School continues its legacy of excellence by incorporating evidence-based research and the latest technology to help our students succeed. Our new state-of-the-art campus in Madison, MS provides the ideal setting for this specialized instruction. We are proud to be a part of the OPTION Schools network worldwide, providing quality listening and spoken language instruction for children who are Deaf or Hard of Hearing. Additionally, we are pioneers in incorporating sensory integration techniques in our classrooms and throughout our school.

The Magnolia Speech School Curriculum is the cornerstone of our instruction, delivered by dedicated teachers and support staff in small groups and individual therapy sessions. We are committed to providing our students and their families with the tools they need to thrive in traditional education settings upon graduation from Magnolia Speech School.



Our Programs

Early Intervention

The Early Intervention Program at Magnolia Speech School is designed for children from birth to age three. It offers comprehensive support through home-based or center-based services. The program provides emotional and educational support to families and children, ensuring developmental milestones in listening and speech are achieved.

Language Disordered

The Language Disordered Program at Magnolia Speech School is dedicated to helping children with neurologically based language disorders such as dyslexia, apraxia, receptive and expressive language disorders, and auditory processing. Our goal is for each student to reach their full potential and integrate into a regular public or private school and function independently.

Hearing Impaired

At Magnolia Speech School, our Hearing-Impaired Program focuses on helping children overcome the challenges of hearing loss through early identification and intervention. Our teachers are highly specialized and well trained in techniques and methodologies to teach oral language, speech, and listening skills and all academics.

Clinic

Magnolia Speech School's Clinic Services offer a full range of evaluations and therapies to support children's developmental and educational needs. Our clinic provides expert services in various areas to ensure children receive the individualized care they require which includes Speech and Language Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Audition Therapy, Physical Therapy, Dyslexia Therapy and Instruction of the Association Method.

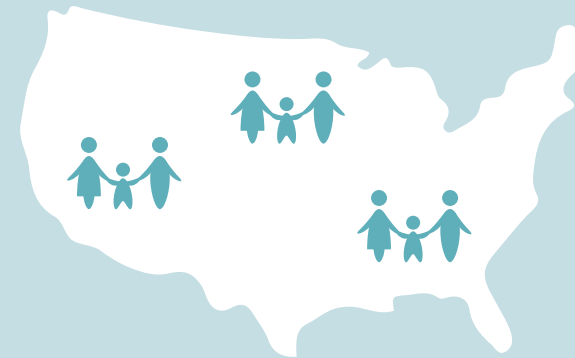
